- NHS 10 year plan is due to be published next month.
- Concept of Integration is here to stay, Frimley Health & Care ICS is leading the way.

3 Priority areas:

- General practice:
 - 4 Network plans delivered covering all of East Berkshire
 - All have identified areas of improvement for 18/19 and longer term plans for sustainability and transformation
 - Funding identified from ICS for short term investment

3 Priority areas:

- Integrated Care Decision Making:
 - Programme refresh identified:
 - Good leadership, programme management and will on the ground
 - Vision, ambition and scope for ICDM programme needed clarifying
 - Need to move away from traditional service focus to a culture of joint working
 - Progress:
 - Model defined, to include cohorts but also business as usual for 18+ yrs
 - Key features of the model agreed:

3 Priority areas:

- Integrated Care Decision Making key features:
 - Regular MDT meetings – complex and anticipatory (expect high demand)
 - Anticipatory approach – new way of working and additional care-planning/interventions
 - Locality Access Points with physically co-located staff for all referrals
 - Physically co-located teams working 8am-8pm M-F core (plus weekends for response services)
 - Integrated community teams ‘in-reaching’ to hospital and joint decision making to facilitate discharge / discharge to assess

3 Priority areas:

- Commissioning in the ICS
 - All 3 CCGs agreed to meet as committees in common
 - 19/20 plan will be signed off in this forum
 - Joint executive team from all CCGs has met and will do so regularly
 - Work commenced on mapping commissioning activities in an ICS environment
